what is the definition of routine maintenance?

Routine means a regular course or procedure; ordinary, commonplace tasks, chores or duties as must be done regularly or at specified intervals (reference [www.dictionary.com](http://www.dictionary.com) ). Routine maintenance would include activities such as snow plowing and removal, mowing, weed control, gravel road grading and dragging operations, street sweeping, pothole filling, minor curb repair, routine ditch cleanout, isolated sign replacements, etc. The expectation of the Federal Fund Purchase Program is for local public agencies (LPAs) to use the proceeds for system improvement (construction and reconstruction) and preventative maintenance projects (overlay, crack seal, armor coat, slurry seal, etc.). Although the Federal Fund Purchase Program allows much more flexibility than Federal-aid projects in terms of types of projects allowed, the intent is not to substitute the proceeds for funds that normally go towards routine maintenance activities.
