



## NEBRASKA "MOVE OVER" LAW AND PENALTIES:

- Statute # - [§60-6,6378](#)
- Effective August 30, 2009
- Any driver in a vehicle on a controlled access highway approaching a stopped emergency or road assistance vehicle with flashing lights must vacate the lane closest to stopped vehicle.
- If driver is unable to safely vacate lane closest to stopped vehicle, the driver must reduce speed and maintain a safe speed and distance while passing.
- Any driver in violation of "Move Over" law who violates this is guilty of a traffic infraction.
- First offense may be fined up to \$100.00.
- Any driver who subsequently violates this provision a second time or more may be sentenced up to seven (7) days in jail, a fine of up to \$500.00, or both.
