


2014 NEBRASKA TEEN DRIVER FACTS

Teen drivers ages 19 & younger represent 7.1% of all licensed drivers in Nebraska; includes all Learner's Permits (LPD), School Permits (SCP), and Provisional Operator's Permits (POP).

67% of Teen Drivers Involved in Fatal Crashes were NOT Wearing Their Safety Belts

TEEN DRIVERS (Ages 19 & Younger) WERE INVOLVED IN:

- 20% of all reported crashes
- 17% of crashes between **9 p.m. and midnight**
- 15% of crashes between **midnight and 3 a.m.**
- 26% of crashes using a **cell phone**
- 32% of **"exceeding the speed limit"** crashes
- 16% of **"failure to yield"** crashes
- 26% of all single-vehicle **rollover** crashes
- 21% of crashes due to **"road conditions"** which were wet and/or snowy
- 25% of **"speed too fast for conditions"** crashes
- 26% of **rear-end type** collisions
- 12% of **alcohol-involved** crashes
- 14% of all crashes were teen **female drivers**
- 13% of all crashes were teen **male drivers**
