



PLATTEVIEW ROAD INTERCHANGE

PROJECT NO. NH-75-2(164), C.N. 21849B

LOCATION: The project will begin approximately 1 ¼ miles west of the existing Platteview Road/US-75 intersection in Sarpy County and will proceed east for approximately 2 miles.

INTENT OF PROJECT: The project will replace the existing at-grade Platteview Road intersection approximately ½ mile south with a safer diamond type interchange.

SCOPE OF WORK: The proposed 2 miles of improvements to Platteview Road will begin approximately 1 ¼ miles west of the existing Platteview Road/US-75 intersection in Sarpy County and will proceed east for approximately 2 miles. A new diamond interchange will be constructed with ramps providing access in all directions of travel. The project will end just east of the railroad. Platteview Road will be extended to the east to the new Missouri River bridge as part of a separate project. Existing US-75 intersections at Allied Road and 10th Street will be removed. 10th Street will be extended to the north and will tie-in with Platteview Road. Allied Road will be constructed along the east side of US-75 and will also tie-in with Platteview Road.

BRIDGE: One bridge over the railroad will be constructed as part of this project for Platteview Road. The Platteview Road bridge over US-75 will be constructed as part of the US-75 Plattsmouth to Bellevue Project.

ACCOMMODATION OF TRAFFIC: Traffic will be maintained during construction. Temporary roads will be constructed to accommodate traffic.

RIGHT-OF-WAY NEEDS: Right-of-way and temporary construction easements will be required.

WETLANDS: Wetlands will be impacted with mitigation to be established within the project corridor.
